Reporting to the **VP of New Projects**, the Project Manager will lead the project team comprised of the owner's team/PMC – Project Management Consultant, contractors, consultants, vendor's reps and coordinate with project stakeholders for successful project completion.

Responsibilities include:

- Develop and implement action plans to meet the project targets. Define the strategy; elaborate the scope of work for specialized consultants and contractors. Organize the owner's team and / or PMC.
- Set up the owner's team or PMC services, contracting strategy for the project development and organize the project accordingly.
- Monitor and control the owner's team, contractors, consultants and vendors by holding update meetings regularly while monitoring progress and making necessary changes.
- Establish project budgets and control project expenditures with support of the project team.
- Ensure detailed reports are produced as per the Company's requirements in a factual and timely manner.
- Enhance the Project Staffing Plan with owner and consultants' personnel and lead the hiring process.
- Organize and provide guidelines for engineering, construction, procurement, contracts, pre-operations and commissioning, organizing each stage of the project
- Identify and account for any deviations from the plan. Determine and implement corrective actions as required.
- Responsible for safe operations and all staff working on the projects.
- Oversee and monitor the activities of Community Relations for the project in coordination with the project representative.
